

OKLAHOMA ACADEMIC SCHOLARS PROGRAM

\$16,000

- \$2,000 per semester/\$4,000 per year for four years to help offset the costs of fees, books, or housing and food
- Funded by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and is subject to change
- Must maintain a 3.25 cumulative GPA, be enrolled full time at OU (min. 12 hours/semester), and complete at least 24 OU credit hours each academic year
- Can be used toward any graduate/professional program at OU if funds remain after completion of undergraduate degree. Student must be admitted to graduate program on own merit.

TUITION WAIVER \$26,100

(est. value)

- Waives 100% of resident tuition for five years (fall and spring semesters)
- Must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA, be enrolled full time at OU (min. 12 hours/semester), and complete at least 24 OU credit hours each
 academic year
- Can be used toward any graduate/professional program at OU if funds remain after completion of undergraduate degree. Student must be admitted to graduate program on own merit.

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP

Please note: This is not the comprehensive Terms of Scholarship for the Oklahoma State Regents' Institutional Nominee Scholarship Package at OU. More detailed terms are sent directly to students who choose to enroll at OU.

If you are within the duration of your Regents' Institutional Nominee Scholarship tuition waiver and stipend and plan to apply either award towards an OU graduate program or an OU pre-professional program, you must contact OU Admissions and Recruitment to complete appropriate paperwork/determine eligibility. The OU graduate or OU pre-professional program must be consecutive to completion of undergraduate degree. Your Regents' Institutional Nominee Scholarship cannot be applied to any Oklahoma Scholar-Leadership Enrichment Program (OSLEP), distance learning courses, correspondence courses, independent study, non-reciprocal study abroad programs, and Professional and Continuing Studies programs both in undergraduate and/or graduate studies. Eligible students may take a leave of absence (LOA) for up to one year from the program for a period during which you are not enrolled in college courses. In order to be granted a LOA, students need to submit required documentation for approval. We will review LOA requests on a semester-by-semester basis. A LOA may not be used to remedy a grade point average or credit hour deficiency. The following are the amounts, duration, and criteria for maintaining eligibility for each part of your award:

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Must be enrolled full-time (at least 12 hours) at the end of the second week of classes each fall and spring semester.
- Must complete at least 24 OU credit hours each academic year.
- If you do not successfully complete 12 credit hours in a semester, you will need to enroll in and successfully complete enough hours the following semester to have received 24 hours over the academic year. You will receive course credit for a grade above an F.

REGENTS' SCHOLAR RESIDENT TUITION WAIVER

- 100% of the resident tuition is waived, regardless of how many hours for which you enroll each semester (as long as you are full-time enrolled and complete at least 24 OU credit hours each academic year) for five consecutive academic years during the fall and spring semesters (starting fall 2025).
- Must maintain a cumuliative GPA of 2.0 at the end of each academic semester.
- Funds will be deposited into Bursar account the week before classes start.

Note: If tuition increases while in school, the tuition waiver will continue to cover the increased amount.

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- Annual cash stipend \$4,000; \$2,000 each fall and spring for four consecutive academic years (starting fall 2025).
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 at the end of each academic semester.
- Funds will be deposited into Bursar account after the second week of classes.

ACADEMIC PROBATIONARY PERIOD

- If a student's cumulative GPA and/or enrolled credit hours fall below the GPA or enrolled credit hours requirements for the tuition waiver and/or scholarship stipend, they will be notified by **OU Admissions & Recruitment** to receive a student success plan as detailed below.
- Tuition Waiver: If a student falls below the minimum requirements, they will be placed on probation for one semester, at which time they will still receive their tuition waiver. During the paid probationary semester, the student must raise their cumulative GPA and/or hours enrolled to the minimum requirements to continue receiving their award. If the award minimums are not met, the student has one additional semester of probation (unpaid) to meet the minimum requirements. A student has a maximum of one year to meet the award requirements. If the minimum requirements are not met after one year of probation, the award is discontinued.
- Oklahoma Academic Scholars Program Award: If a student falls below the minimum GPA and enrollment requirements, they will be placed on unpaid probation from receiving this portion of their award for up to one year. After a maximum of a one-year unpaid probationary period, this portion of the student's scholarship will be discontinued if award minimums are not met. At any point within the probationary year that award minimums are met, this portion of the award will be reinstated.
