





Norman Campus Research and Sponsored Program Expenditures, FY 2011 - 2020




Norman Campus Awards Received FY 2016 - 2020




Norman Campus Research and Sponsored Program Expenditures by Source FY 2020





Norman Campus Research Expenditures by Source, FY 2011 - 2020



Norman Campus Research and Sponsored Program Expenditures Direct from Federal Agencies, FY 2020




Norman Campus Research Expenditures Direct from Federal Agencies FY 2011 - 2020




Expenditure Trends of University Strategic Organizations (USOs), FY 2011 - 2020


Total R & D Expenditures of University Peers, FY 2009 - 2018




Federally-Financed R & D Expenditures of University Peers, FY 2009 - 2018




Norman Campus Papers* Published CY 2015 - 2019





For Works** Published from CY 2017 - 2019 Main Campuses Only






Postdoctoral Fellows* Employed at the Norman Campus Fall 2015 - 2019


