REMINDERS

- Update all Youth Protection Trainings once a year.
- Update background checks for Staff, Faculty members, and Third Party helpers once a year.
- Update Student Conduct Checks for all OU Students every 6 months.
- Clery Training may be needed. This is determined on an event-by-event basis.

FOR ALL UPCOMING INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

- All faculty and staff traveling internationally on official university business, including study abroad, conferences, and research, must register their travel in the International Travel Registry at least 30 days prior to departure.
- Faculty and staff traveling with students must also notify the Office of Global Engagement and Education Abroad (GE/EA) in advance.
- All students participating in university-sponsored international travel are required to enroll in the university's international travel insurance through CISI, which is facilitated by GE/EA.
