Captain Nicholas Maher is the Operations Flight Commander, AFROTC Detachment 675, University of Oklahoma, Norman, OK. He also serves as the Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies in the university's College of Arts and Sciences.

Captain Maher entered the Air Force through the Delayed Entry Program in February of 2001 and entered active duty on 14 September 2001. As an Enlisted Airman, he served as a Security Forces member, Manpower Analyst and as a Professional Military Education Instructor. Captain Maher commissioned through OTS in Nov 2017.

He was previously the Director of Operations 366th Logistics Readiness Squadron, Mountain Home Air Force Base, Idaho. He was responsible for the overall leadership and management of 273 military and civilian personnel by overseeing safety, welfare, and career development. Additionally, Captain Maher manages and directs resources to meet mission requirements for 33,000 assets, and a \$353,000,000 warehouse, supporting forty-seven F-15Es and four thousand member base.



Previous assignments include Malmstrom AFB, Montana, Randolph AFB, Texas, Lajes Field, Portugal, and Ramstein AB Germany and Kapaun AS, Germany, Joint Base Charleston, South Carolina and Mountain Home AFB, Idaho.
