### CAPTAIN TRAVIS W. MOORE

Captain Travis W. Moore is the Academic Officer, AFROTC Detachment 675, University of Oklahoma, Norman, Okla. He also serves as the Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies in the university's College of Arts and Sciences.

Captain Moore entered the Air Force through BMT in July 2010. As a prior enlisted member, he served as a KC-135 instructor boom operator at McConnell AFB, KS accumulating over 2300 flight hours and 146 combat sorties during eight deployments. The Captain was commissioned as a distinguished graduate of OTS in June 2018. He now has a combined 12 years of service.

Prior to his current position, he was stationed at the Space Systems Command, Los Angeles Air Force Base, California, where he was the Chief, Next-Gen GEO OPIR Communication Architecture, where he led an integrated product team of engineers and contractors responsible for designing, developing, and fielding the space communication systems for the nation's next missile warning constellation. He was responsible for the cost, schedule, and performance of over 17 communications subsystems critical to the operations of a program valued at more than \$8B, providing resilient and unambiguous global missile detection and warning for Combatant Commanders and the President. He also served as the CASINO Ground Lead in the Innovation and Prototyping Directorate, where he led the development of innovative cloud-based ground processing, exploitation, and dissemination prototypes in support of proliferated LEO operations and supported DARPA's novel Blackjack program.



Captian Moore has held various positions as an enlisted aviator, including the NCOIC Training for the 350th Air Refueling Squadron and the 22nd Operations Group. He also participated in multiple multinational training exercises as the Chief Boom, Tanker Operations for Red Flag Eielson, and Mobility Guardian.
