Tech. Sgt. Dilbert is an Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps (AFROTC) Training Instructor, Detachment 675, University of Oklahoma, Norman, Oklahoma. In this position, he provides oversight of administrative tasks for over 130 cadets, supporting cadet life cycle management and completing actions for contracting, commissioning, Extended Active Duty (EAD), AFROTC Field Training, and other events/programs. In addition, he assists the Professors of Aerospace Studies (PAS) in educating cadets on the AFROTC curriculum, which encompasses character, honor, general military skills, and human relations.

Tech. Sgt. Dilbert was born and raised in New York and enlisted in the Air Force in May 2008. He graduated from Technical School in September 2008 as a Security Forces Apprentice. His background includes a myriad of positions at the Squadron and Wing levels. TSgt. Dilbert deployed multiple times in support of Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM, FREEDOM'S SENTINEL, INHERENT RESOLVE AND OCTAVE SHIELD. During the support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM TSgt Dilbert participated in detainee operations where his attention to detail lead to over 200 hands-on insurgent transfers resulting in zero escapes and incident free events. In Al Jaber Air Base where he was selected as shift leader overseeing a 1.2-million-dollar Tactical Automated Security System securing over 51 million munitions on a



host nation installation. During his time in Kuwait, he orchestrated an investigation with the United States Marines and Kuwait forces on multiple force protection threats increasing security posture and ensuring the safety of coalition forces.
