- Academic Affairs:

 - O Senator Ulrich (11): We met with the dean of the grad college to discuss results of the Grad SERU survey. They said this survey will be sent out periodically in the future too, so our committee discussed ideas for questions we might ask to add as well as what we would do with that data.
- Human Diversity:
 - O Senator Tomte (96): Met with Calvin White in office of DEI. We discussed ideas to raise awareness on campus and he referred me to another person who handles graduate student inclusion.
- Internal Affairs:
 - o Senator Norris (112): Nothing new to report.
- International Student Affairs:
 - Senator Munteanu (49): we talked about possibly creating a survey but hope to make it short in order to improve response rate. We want to extend programs that are available to

undergraduate students but not graduate students to include grad students. We want to avoid situations where international grad students arrive in the country and have nowhere to stay for a week or so. We got a discouraging email from OU about our ideas for a ride sharing program/bus routes for groceries. They recommended a bike sharing program.

• Public Relations:
