SHURBAJI v. SGA ELECTION BOARD

Bourland, CHIEF JUSTICE, delivered the unanimous opinion of the Court.

What follows is a Summary Order for this appeal. The Court did not write an official opinion. This Order contains the reasoning of the Court.

We have decided to REVERSE the decision by the Election Board on the grievance against the Shurbaji Campaign based on the campaign buttons in Walker 8.

While we hold candidates liable for the actions of their campaigners, we have to know that the person who committed the offense was actually acting on behalf of the Campaign. There is absolutely no evidence of who committed the infraction, so there is no way to know if it was expressly or impliedly on behalf of the Campaign.

The ruling of the Election Board is REVERSED. Reduce the number of grievances against the Shurbaji Campaign by 1.

This is the opinion of the Court.
