CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-100-40

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act amending the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws to reform the liaison program, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Liaison Reform Act".

Section 2: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to make liaisonship mandatory for all members in the Undergraduate Student Congress.

Section 3: AMENDING: Section 4.4 of the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws are hereby amended. All additions are marked with an <u>underline</u> and all deletions are marked with a <u>strikethrough</u>:

Section 4.4: LIAISONS

- 1. Any member of the Student Congress may request to become a Liaison All members of the Student Congress are required to be a liaison. Newly elected or appointed members need not meet the liaison requirements listed below during their first month of membership.
- 2. At the discretion of the Vice Chair, any member of the Student Congress may be appointed to serve as <u>a Liaisons</u> of Student Congress to any organizations in the <u>on</u> campus and <u>or within the Norman communities community</u>. The Vice Chair shall maintain a list of <u>prominent aforementioned</u> organizations on campus and in the Norman community that are available <u>have requested and are eligible to receive</u> a liaison.
- 3. Liaisons shall be appointed only after the approval of both the Vice Chair of Congress and the highest authority of the entity that a liaison is being appointed to.
- 4. Representatives must serve as a liaison to an organization within the Academic District they have been elected or appointed to represent. At the discretion of the Vice Chair of Congress and the highest authority in the desired student organization, Representatives may be the liaison to an organization that serves a large portion of the student body.
- 5. <u>Associates shall serve as at-large liaisons. The Vice Chair of Congress must assign them to an available organization.</u>
 - 4. Liaisons shall attend meetings, functions, programs, and events of the organizations or entities to which they are assigned, and report back any pertinent business or concerns during the appropriate section of the general meetings.
- 6. Liaison Requirements include:

- a. RSO MEETING ATTENDANCE: Liaisons must attend one (1) meeting of their assigned organization each month that Congress holds a general meeting. This requirement must be met by attending the organization's general meeting, an executive committee meeting, or a personal meeting with an executive officer.
- b. RSO EVENT ATTENDANCE: Liaisons must attend one (1) event hosted by their assigned organization by 1 week before the end of each Congressional Session.
- c. At the discretion of the Congress Vice Chair, liaisons unable to complete a requirement(s) are eligible to participate in an alternate form of service to fulfill said requirement(s).
- d. <u>Each Liaison Requirement must be submitted via OrgSync. The Congress Vice Chair will then either approve or deny the form if the requirement is met.</u>
- 7. On the Sunday of the last week of the month, the Vice Chair will notify all liaisons who have not completed the RSO Meeting Attendance Requirement. Two weeks before the end of each Congressional Session, the Vice Chair will notify all liaisons who have not completed the RSO Event Attendance Requirement.
- 8. Members shall accrue an absence for failure to meet a Liaison Requirement or for failure to submit proper documentation by the dates detailed in Section 4.4(6)(a) and Section 4.4(6)(b).
 - 5. In each month, a liaison shall be excused from any one constituent service requirement, if said liaison performs his or her liaison position responsibilities, including a report during a general meeting, in said month.
- Section 4: This act shall become effective upon the commencement of The University of Oklahoma's Spring 2019 Academic Semester, if passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-100-41

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act amending the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws to amend the constituent service requirement, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- **Section 1:** Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Constituent Service Reform Act".
- **Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to change the Constituent Service Requirement to a Congressional Service Requirement for all members in the Undergraduate Student Congress.
- **Section 3:** AMENDING: Section 4.3(3) of the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws are hereby amended. All additions are marked with an <u>underline</u> and all deletions are marked with a <u>strikethrough</u>:

3. CONSTITUENT CONGRESSIONAL SERVICE REQUIREMENT

- a. Each member shall meet his or her their constituent service requirement Congressional

 Service Requirement each month that Student Congress holds a general meeting. Newly elected or appointed members need not meet a constituent service requirement

 Congressional Service Requirement during their first month of membership. Constituent service Congressional Service shall be submitted to the Student Congress Secretary. For constituent service responsibilities, constituent service is The Congressional Service

 Requirement is expected to be fulfilled as listed below.
- b. Members shall accrue an absence for failure to meet a constituent service requirement Congressional Service Requirement or for failure to submit proper documentation to the Student Congress Secretary by the final day of the month at 11:59pm.
- c. Constituent service requirements Congressional Service Requirements include:
 - i. Representatives and Associates must be present monthly for one (1) hour of office hours to be held between 9am and 5pm Monday thru Friday in the Conoco Student—Leadership Center. This is a requirement for February, March, April, September, October, and November.
 - i. Representatives and Associates must work one (1) designated shift at a congressional event each month that Congress holds a general meeting. This requirement shall be waived at the discretion of the Congress Secretary.

- ii. All Representatives and Associates must ensure the Secretary gets their biography (including name, major, year, and goals/legislative ideas for the session) within the first 2 weeks of their election or appointment.
- iii. One hour of additional Constituent Service must be completed each month. This hour can be completed by accomplishing any of the following tasks
 - 1. Introduce the mission of SGA and Student Congress to constituents at the regular meeting of a Registered Student Organization (RSO), and obtaining feedback from the RSO concerning current Congressional initiatives and project.
 - Attend a Congressional event intended to increase visibility within the OU
 community. These events will need to be preapproved by the Secretary in
 order to fulfill the requirement.
 - Attend a community event intended to increase awareness or foster understanding for a specific community on campus. These events will need to be pre-approved by the Secretary in order to fulfill the requirement.
 - 4. Attend an event/complete a task posted under the "Constituent Service Opportunity" list on the window of the Secretary's Office.
- iv. All <u>Constituent Service Congressional Service must</u> be submitted via OrgSync. The Secretary will then either approve or deny the form if the service completed satisfies the requirement.
- v. On the 25th of every month, the Secretary will notify all Representatives and Associates of their remaining service requirement.
- d. The following shall be excused from their constituent service responsibility <u>Congressional</u> Service Requirement:
 - i. Members of the Ways and Means Committee, during budget interviews and Primary Funding budgetary periods.
 - ii. Members of the Congressional Administration Committee, following an interview period.
 - iii. All members following a vote of the Student Congress Executive Committee.
- Section 4: This act shall become effective upon the passage of the "Liaison Act Reform Act" and the commencement of The University of Oklahoma's Spring 2019 Academic Semester, if passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.
