CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-102-11 SENATE BILL GSXX-XX/GFXX-XX

#### AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Legislation implementing the Indigenous Land Acknowledgement Statement in SGA events; establishing Title XII of the Code Annotated; providing for short title, providing for codification, and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

**Section 1**: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Indigenous Land Acknowledgement Act."

**Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to implement an Indigenous Land Acknowledgement (ILA) statement as campus-wide introduction that shall be recited before designated events in order to honor the Indigenous community on campus as well as the rich American Indian heritage and history of our University and state.

**Section 3**: NEW LAW: A new chapter and Title is hereby established in Title XII of the Code Annotated to read as follows:

Title XII: Tribal Recognition Chapter 1: Indigenous Land Acknowledgement

## 1. ILA Template

"Before we begin today, The Student Government Association would like to take a moment to honor and recognize the rich heritage and traditions of the land and its peoples on which we are gathered today.

Long before David Ross Boyd envisioned the University of Oklahoma, the land on which we gather today served as a site of meeting and exchange amongst many Indigenous peoples. Tribes such as the Caddo and Wichita and Affiliated tribes called this land home long before the University of Oklahoma was envisioned or established. Today, 39 tribal nations dwell within the state of Oklahoma as a result of policies that were designed to assimilate Native people and strip them of their diverse and sacred cultures and traditions.

This land acknowledgment statement is a public expression of gratitude and honor for the people who have been living on and cultivating this land from time immemorial. Today, many Native people represent their families and tribes from across the land as Indigenous students, faculty and staff here at the University of Oklahoma.

The Student Government Association/Campus Activities Council/Undergraduate Student Congress/ Graduate Student Senate would like to acknowledge that today...

We are visitors on this land.

We are thankful for the privilege and opportunity to be visitors. We would like to recognize all of our Indigenous people who are present today and honor them for allowing us to gather here with them."

- 2. Requirements
- A. The Indigenous Land Acknowledgment shall be stated before the start of SGA events. SGA For the purpose of this Act, tabling on the South Oval should not be considered an event. Further exclusions shall be recurring meetings such as Undergraduate Student Congress Meetings, Graduate Student Senate Meetings, Executive Cabinet meetings, and any informal or formal committee or department that occur on a recurring basis.

- C. Appropriate statement formats

- **Section 4:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

An Act of Procedure amending committee membership for Student Congress Session 102; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

**Section 1**: This Act shall be known and may be cited as "An Act Amending Committee Membership for Session 102."

#### CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-102-18

#### AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act of Procedure amending the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws; providing short title; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

- **Section 1:** Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Problems and Projects Committee Reform Act of 2019".
- Section 2: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to amend the name, committee purpose, and committee chair role of the Problems and Projects Committee in order to ensure a more comprehensive committee that can adequately address student concerns.
- **Section 3:** AMENDATORY: Section 7.1.4 of the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws is amended as follows:
  - 4. PROBLEMS AND PROJECTS CAMPUS OUTREACH, SAFETY, AND CONCERNS
- **Section 4:** AMENDATORY: Section 7.1.4a of the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws is amended as follows:
  - a. COMMITTEE PURPOSE The Problems and Projects <u>Campus Outreach</u>, <u>Safety</u>, and <u>Concerns Committee</u> shall use the Student Congress' resources to manage outreach projects for the Student Congress, resolve all problems <u>concerns</u> regarding university infrastructure, student experience, and all other student problems <u>concerns</u> that the Student Congress <u>the committee</u> mandates itself can reasonably respond to address.
- **Section 5:** AMENDATORY: Section 7.1.4b of the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws is amended as follows:
  - b. COMMITTEE CHAIR The Committee Chair shall be charged with maintaining and following up with the Undergraduate Student Congress electronic suggestion box.

The Committee Chair shall coordinate with the Congress Chair to refer suggestion box submissions to other committees, should they appropriately fall under another committee's responsibilities. The Committee Chair shall work with the Directors of the Department of Inclusivity and Interior in the executive branch to address campus safety and all other student concerns that fall within the committee's purview and mandate.

**Section 6:** AMENDATORY: Section 7.6.4ci of the Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws is amended as follows:

i. Congress Chair, Congress Vice-Chair, Congress Secretary, Congressional Administration Committee Chair, External Affairs Committee Chair, Human Diversity Committee Chair, Problems and Projects Campus Outreach, Safety, and Concerns Committee Chair, University Policy Committee Chair, and Ways and Means Committee Chair.

**Section 7:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.
