AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2016-2017 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Auxiliary Allocation #9 Act of 2017”.

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. GS17-XX

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution thanking Vice President Jabar Shumate, expressing solidarity in response to his official statement on non-citizen students, showing support for international students, scholars, faculty, and staff affected by recent executive orders under the current presidential administration, and providing for distribution.

- Whereas: The University's non-discrimination policy prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, religion, and/or national origin; and
- Whereas: Vice President Shumate expressed that international students, faculty, and staff on the University campus are valued members of the community and should never feel alienated nor discriminated against; and
- Whereas: The University continues to encourage diversity within the staff, faculty, and student body; and
- Whereas: All undergraduate and graduate student applicants are welcome regardless of citizenship status; and
- Whereas: President David L. Boren and Vice President Shumate have both expressed their personal support of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program, which helps individuals pursue and/or continue their education; and
- Whereas: University law enforcement does not address matters related to immigration enforcement on behalf of the federal government; and
- Whereas: The University requires immigration warrants to be lawfully issued before further actions can be taken on campus; and
- Whereas: The University as well as its police force do not inquire about the immigration status of students, scholars, faculty and staff; and
- Whereas: The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) protects student information and is supported by the University in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS THAT:

- Section 1:** This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the “A Joint Resolution Thanking Jabar Shumate and Solidarity Declaration”; and
- Section 2:** The Graduate Student Senate and Undergraduate Student Congress support Vice President Shumate’s letter to the University Community addressing immigrants; and
- Section 3:** The Graduate Student Senate and Undergraduate Student Congress encourage students to show solidarity to their fellow students; and
- Section 4:** The Graduate Student Senate and Undergraduate Student Congress believe diversity contributes to an inclusive and innovative school and work environment; and
- Section 5:** The Graduate Student Senate and Undergraduate Student Congress encourage other student government associations at all of Oklahoma’s public colleges and universities to support similar resolutions; and
- Section 6:** We thank Vice President Shumate for publicly displaying his support to international and immigrant students, scholars, faculty, and staff.
