A resolution showing support and need for expansion of the Crimson Cruiser bike share program at the University of Oklahoma, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Whereas:	The students, faculty, and staff at the University of Oklahoma believe that the accessibility to
	efficient transportation should be readily available to the members of the University; and
Whereas:	The Crimson Cruiser bike share program, in partnership with Social Bicycles and Gotcha Bike,
	two private entities in coalition outside of the University of Oklahoma, assist in providing
	accessible and efficient transportation throughout campus; and
Whereas:	This current program is in effect for a two-year trial period; and
Whereas:	The program has had 4,670 new sign-ups with 3,897 users with at least one rental; and
Whereas:	Approximately 43,134 trips have been taken totaling over 40,119 miles and 8,434 minutes;
	and
Whereas:	Compared to driving, this bike sharing program has reduced carbon emission by 35,378
	pounds at the University of Oklahoma ¹ ; and
Whereas:	The University of Oklahoma welcomed 4,500 freshman students for the 2017-2018 school
	year, in accordance with an all-time high of 28, 541 students enrolled for Fall 2017 ² ; and
Whereas:	The Student Government Association exists to serve and meet the needs of the student
	body; and
Whereas:	The Student Government Association contributed to the institution of the bike share
	program as a service to its constituents; and

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 980801 SENATE BILL NO. GF17-22

AS INTRODUCED

An Act designating poll locations for the Fall 2017 General Elections; providing for codification; providing for a short title; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1: TITLE. This act may be known and shall be cited as the "Polling Location Act of Fall 2017."
- Section 2: PURPOSE. To designate polling locations for the Fall 2017 General Elections.
- Section 3: In accordance with Title VII, Chapter 1, Section 12 of the SGACA, "The number and location of polling places shall be established by an Act of the Legislative Branch," the following polling locations are established for the Fall 2017 SGA General Elections (October 31 and November 1) and reserved for a potential run-off election (November 6):
 - Oklahoma Memorial Union
 - o First floor area near the IT store and radio station
 - Bizzell Memorial Library, Lower Level 1.
