CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 980112 SENATE BILL NO. GF17-XX

AS INTRODUCED

A congressional act amending the Code Annotated to provide for more fair elections, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Even Starting Line Act of 2017."
- **Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to amend the Code Annotated so as to provide for fairer elections.
- **Section 3:** For the purposes of this legislation, all addition shall be marked with an <u>underline</u> and all deletions shall be marked with a <u>strikethrough</u>.
- **Section 4:** Title VII, Chapter 1, Section 1 shall be amended as follows:
 - 1. Definitions

Academic week – Any week (Sunday through Sunday) during which the University holds classes for at least one day.

Business Day – Any day the University is open, even if no classes are held. This includes all week days with the exception of University holidays.

Campaign Spending – The retail value of any obligations incurred; the retail value of any goods and services donated and any actual funds expended to promote or oppose the election of any individual to any SGA office. This definition shall include the value of any discounts not available to the general public and the retail value of any donated professional services (such as printing, graphic design, entertainment, and advertising). It shall not include any fines assessed under this Code or the value of donated non-professional services (services performed entirely by University of Oklahoma students).

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 980303

AS INTRODUCED

	A Concurrent Resolution issuing support to all recipients of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), both at the University of Oklahoma and elsewhere in the country, and providing for distribution.
Whereas:	The faculty, students and staff at the University of Oklahoma believe in the dignity and potential of every student; and
Whereas:	The Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) federal program provides an opportunity for undocumented individuals to pursue an education and is at risk of being eliminated; and
Whereas:	The removal of DACA would place its recipients under immediate risk of deportation, thus ending their educational path; and
Whereas:	There are nearly 7,500 DACA recipients in Oklahoma, some of whom are students at the University of Oklahoma, and if it is eliminated their future is uncertain; and
Whereas:	The Student Government Association strives to serve all students, everyday: and
Whereas:	This service extends to those who are on the DACA program, also known as "Dreamers"; and
Whereas:	SGA places the utmost value in each and every Dreamer in the OU family, and they are respected and accepted as integral members of our community; and
Whereas:	DACA students should be allowed to continue their education, whether it be at the University of Oklahoma or elsewhere in the United States of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS AND GRADUATE STUDENT SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN THAT:

Section 1: This Concurrent Resolution shall be called "A Resolution Affirming Support for the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals Program and its Recipients."

- **Section 2:** The Undergraduate Student Congress and the Graduate Student Senate, on behalf of the students of the University of Oklahoma, encourage the United States Congress to pass legislation to protect these individuals and to facilitate their attainment of citizenship.
- **Section 3:** The Undergraduate Student Congress and the Graduate Student Senate, on behalf of the students of the University of Oklahoma, thank President David L. Boren for his support of the Dreamers on our campus and encourage everyone at the University of Oklahoma to show the same support.

Whereas:	President David L. Boren served as a United States Senator from Oklahoma between January of 1979 to November of 1994; and
Whereas:	President David L. Boren continues to serve as the 13 th President of the University of Oklahoma from 1994 to the present; and
Whereas:	President David L. Boren has increased recruitment e orts for academically high achieving students the University having more National Merit Scholars enrolled than any other Public or Private University; and
Whereas:	President David L. Boren's tenure at the University of Oklahoma has been marked by unprecedented success in the University's history, including the University being named as one of the top 100 Universities in the United States for the rst time; and
Whereas:	President David L. Boren has announced his intention to retire after 51 dedicated years of service to the state of Oklahoma, including 23 years of service at the University of Oklahoma.
