CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 990112

AS INTRODUCED

A congressional act codifying a process for appointment interviews, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1:** Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “The Interview Specification Act of 2018”
- Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act is inherent in the title.
- Section 3:** For the purpose of this bill, all additions shall be marked with an underline and all deletions with a ~~striketrough~~.
- Section 4:** Section 3.2- QUALIFICATION FOR AND CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP, sub-section 3 shall be amended as follows:
- iii. The *Congressional Administration Committee* shall write the application for membership
 - 1. Within a month of the end of a session, the Congressional Administration Chair shall consult with the Vice-Chair and the Secretary of the Congressional Administration Committee to create a rubric for evaluating both candidate applications and interviews during that semester. This rubric, pending approval from the Congressional Administration Committee of that same session, shall be used to adjudicate all applicants during the following session.
- Section 5:** Section 3.2- QUALIFICATION FOR AND CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP, sub-section 3 shall be amended as follows:
- v. After the close of the application period, the Congressional Administration Committee shall interview membership applicants at the committee’s discretion
 - 1. All interviewers must have completed some form of selection-bias training prior to conducting interviews.
- Section 6:** Section 3.2- QUALIFICATION FOR AND CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP, sub-section 3 shall be amended as follows:
- vii. The Congressional Administration Committee shall author an act of procedure appointing members of Student Congress. This act shall be on the Items to be Considered agenda of the next general meeting following candidate interviews.

1. Final deliberations concerning the creation of the bill appointing representatives and associates shall only occur among interviewers who have been present for the entire session of interviews.

Section 7: Section 4.3- OTHER STUDENT CONGRES POSITIONS shall be amended as follows:

e. Congressional Administration Committee Chair

i. The Congressional Administration Chair shall have the power to determine what training satisfies the selection-bias training under Section 3.2 of these Bylaws

ii. The Congressional Administration Chair shall conduct a selection-bias training prior to the first round of interviews of any given session

Section 8: This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

AS INTRODUCED

A congressional act changing the due date for Primary Funding applications, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Primary Funding Application Due Date Change Act”.

Section 2: The purpose of this act shall be to change the due date of Primary Funding Applications.

Section 3: AMENDATORY: All additions are marked with an underline and all deletions are marked with a ~~striketrough~~. Title X, Chapter 4, Section 20, Subsection a. of the Code Annotated is hereby amended to read:

Title X – Finance

Chapter 4 – Budgetary Procedures

20. Primary Budget Process

The Primary Budget Process shall be held in the spring semester of every year.

a. Eligibility

Each organization must meet all of these requirements

- i. Registration: Only those registered student organizations that are located on the Norman campus will be funded. Any student organization that is affiliated with the University of Oklahoma but not located on the Norman campus will not receive funding through this campus. Each organization shall be registered with the Office of Student Life one consecutive calendar year prior to the Primary Budget deadline and must re-register within four weeks of registration opening in the fall semester in accordance with the Student Activities Policy.
- ii. Budget Deadline: Each organization must submit their budget application by the ~~Thursday~~ Friday of the sixth week of classes in the Spring semester. The Chair of the SGA Budgetary Committee shall determine the specific time, date, location, and method the budget applications are due.
- iii. Budget Deadline Enforcement: Any organization who submits a budget after this time shall be considered ineligible for funding at the discretion of the Chair of the SGA Budgetary Committee; this decision is subject to reversal by the majority of the SGA Budgetary Committee.
- iv. Budgetary Form Submission Requirement: Organizations are required to fill out the supplementary Budgetary Form on OrgSync whenever they submit a budget for funding. Upon review of an organizations budget and budgetary form, if the SGA Budgetary Committee has any further questions or concerns they may email the organization for clarification. The creation of the SGA Budgetary Form shall be left up to the discretion of the SGA Budgetary Committee.

- v. Standing: Only those student organizations in good standing with SGA and the University of Oklahoma shall be funded. Any student organization that is not in good standing shall not receive funding.

Section 4: This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2017-2018 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Auxiliary Allocation 18 Act of 2017-2018”.

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.
