Whereas: Those who comprise the university of Oklahoma's student body come from a variety

of backgrounds and experiences.

Whereas: The University of Oklahoma is considered above average in ethnic, gender,

geographic, and overall diversity.¹

Whereas: Unfortunately, the University of Oklahoma also has a history of insensitivity and

bigotry, from the racist "Little Red" mascot in the 1950s to the incidents of

Blackface in 2019.

Whereas: Several initiatives have already been created to combat racists forces on our campus-

like the multicultural advancement committee- but we as the Student Government Association legislative branch should also define and solidify our continued efforts.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: Title: This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the "Resolution for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion within the Student Government Association."

AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution Increasing Halal, Vegan, and Gluten-Free Signage in Campus Dining Areas; providing for a short title; and providing for distribution

Whereas: The University of Oklahoma's mission is to "create an enhanced learning environment

based on diversity and inclusion."

Whereas: There are rarely signs in dining areas around campus indicating what foods are

gluten-free, Halal, or vegan.

Whereas: The Hindu, Muslim, and Jewish populations have dealt with the uncertainty of not knowing

if the food they are eating is in compliance with their religion. Halal and Kosher are religiously ideal foods for Muslims and Jews respectively and some Hindus are strict

vegetarians as well.

Whereas: Many universities have adapted menus for different religions and international students. The

University of Chicago has developed a dedicated Halal counter in their catering services 1 and the University of California accommodates Muslim, vegetarian and vegan students. 2

Whereas: A brief survey of Muslim students and faculty showed that they would find it

ideal if food were to be labeled Halal and they could have more options. Due to

inaccessibility of Kosher food on campus, the Jewish student population has resorted to

vegan options.

Whereas: Organizations serving food in the Union have to abide by the rule of using Union

catering, which does not offer Halal food as an option to be served.

Whereas: In events like Housing & Food organized Thanksgiving dinner, only traditional American

food is served which is restrictive for many students from different cultures and with

different diets.

Whereas: Housing & Food is currently looking for a larger distributor for Halal meat.

Whereas: The university already has menus indicating what foods across campus are gluten-free,

vegan, and halal, but they are not advertised.

Whereas: There is no system in place to label these kinds of foods in dining spaces across campus.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-103-09 SENATE BILL NO. GFXX-XX

AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Legislation mandating a name change for the "Sooner Freshman Council"; providing for short title, providing for codification, and providing for an effective date.

- **Section 1:** This Act shall be known as the "Inclusivity Consistency Act"
 - a. Student Government Association strives to be an inclusive organization.
 - b. The word "Sooner" is harmful in nature to those who identify as American Indian or of Native/Indigenous descent.
 - c. The Student Government Association wants to be consistent in its application of an Indigenous Land Acknowledgment at its events and ceremonies.
 - d. The Student Government Association just passed, signed, and subsequently codified an Indigenous Land Acknowledgement in the Code Annotated creating Title XII.
 - e. The Student Government Association must strive to include all, thereby mandating a more sensitive name must be selected and instituted within the first two weeks of the Fall semester in year 2020.
- Section 2: This Act shall give the Executive Branch in collaboration with the Co-Chairs of Sooner Freshman Council a deadline of September 1st, 2020.
 - A. The name that replaces "Sooner Freshman Council" must have the following stipulations:
 - a. The name "Sooner Freshman Council" or "SFC" must be taken off all relevant social media including handles.
 - b. The name must be changed on all websites including registered student organization portals including, but not limited to, the SGA Website and OrgSync.
- Section 3: Once the new name is proposed, it must be submitted to the Executive Branch including but not limited to the President and/or Vice-President within the time specified in Section 2.
 - A. Once the Executive Branch approves the name, it must be represented to the Legislative through the appropriate committees and will thereby be subject to review by the Undergraduate Student Congress and Graduate Student Senate.
- **Section 4:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.
