- **Congressional Administration:** So, we looked at a bunch of different things and identified projects including election reform. We saw CB-103-10 and CB-103-11 and gave both of them a recommendation of do pass.
- **External Affairs:** I am very proud of External Affairs. This is the best one I've seen out of three sessions. We had a great voter registration drive. We did a lot better in city council meetings and being up to date on the city of Norman.
- **Human Diversity:** We were really great this semester and we are really excited next semester. We had a forum for affordable housing and a forum for mass incarceration, as well as hosting the Friendsgiving.
- **Sustainability:** Our committee also did very well this semester. We've had multiple trash walks, we had a food justice summit, and a reusable upcycling event. Finally, we are also laying the ground work for the reusable container program for OU. This is going to be a really positive thing as long as the university can provide funding. We will also be having a healthy eating event, as well as tabling an education opportunity promoting sustainability through the idea of less waste. AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2019-2020 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Auxiliary Allocation 12 Act of 2019-2020"
- **Section 2:** PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.
