CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION CR-104-09 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. GFXX-XX/GSXX-XX

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution Adding a polling location on campus; and providing for distribution.

Whereas: 48.6% of the undergraduate student body at The University of Oklahoma voted in

the 2016 presidential election, a 7.5% improvement from the 2012 presidential

election¹; and,

Whereas: 33.3% of the undergraduate student body at The University of Oklahoma voted in

the 2018 election, a 17.5% improvement from the 2014 presidential election²; and,

Whereas: In 2014, 3.2% of undergraduate students at The University of Oklahoma voted by

way of early voting with that number increasing to 6.9% in 2018⁷; and,

Whereas: This demonstrates an increase in demand for early voting among students on our

campus; and,

Whereas: Studies have shown that voting once significantly increases the probability of voting

again in subsequent elections, indicating that voter turnout will be maintained³; and,

Whereas: Currently, the closest early voting site to campus is 3 miles from the Residence Halls.

> These sites are open from 8am – 6pm on the Thursday and Friday and 9am to 2pm on the Saturday prior to election day. This trip equates to a 15-minute bus ride as

well as a 1.7 mile (34-minute walk) to the voting site^{4.5}.

Whereas: One of the University of Oklahoma's core values is that, "the mission of the
