AS INTRODUCED

An Act allocating office space in the Conoco Student Leadership Center for 2020-2021; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “2020-2021 Conoco Student Leadership Center Space Allocations Act.”

Section 2: The purpose of this Act is inherent in its title.

Section 3: The Registered Student Organizations provided in Section 4 shall retain their designated allocations until May 2021.

Section 4: This Section shall allow the temporary nullification of the Code Annotated Title XI, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsections a, b, e, and f, as necessary, to preserve the allocations designated to the above Registered Student Organizations until May 2021. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to nullify, modify, or otherwise affect any other subsection therein.

Section 5: University of Oklahoma COVID-19 policies and regulations must be observed in all allocated spaces; otherwise, the Registered Student Organizations will be penalized for any violation of such policies and regulations.

Section 6: This Act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-104-21

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act of Procedure including a requirement in the COSCO purpose; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “The Mandatory COSCO Light Walk Act.”

Section 2: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to clarify the specific role of the Campus Outreach, Safety, and Concerns committee with regards to light walks on campus. This is to ensure the safety of students walking on campus at night or at times where lights are necessary. It also ensures that light walks will be done regularly.

Section 3: AMENDATORY: Section 7.1 of the Undergraduate Student Congress By-Laws is amended as follows. For the purposes of this bill, all items removed shall be denoted with a ~~strike through~~. All items added shall be denoted with an underline.

Section 7: COMMITTEES

Section 7.1: STANDING COMMITTEE ESTABLISHMENT

The seven (7) standing committees (also referenced in these Bylaws as “committees”) and their responsibilities shall be as follows:

4. CAMPUS OUTREACH, SAFETY, AND CONCERNS

- a. COMMITTEE PURPOSE The Campus Outreach, Safety, and Concerns Committee shall use the Student Congress’s resources to resolve all concerns regarding university infrastructure, student experience, and all other student concerns that the committee mandates itself to address. The Campus Outreach, Safety, and Concerns Committee shall complete a mandatory light walk each month Congress has a general body meeting and classes are held on campus.
- b. COMMITTEE CHAIR The Committee Chair shall be charged with maintaining and following up with the Undergraduate Student Congress electronic suggestion box. The Committee Chair shall coordinate with the Congress Chair to refer suggestion box submissions to other committees, should they more appropriately fall under another committee’s responsibilities.

Section 4: This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Legislation establishing the Vice Chair of the Student Government Association as the official Big XII Coordinator; providing for short title, providing for codification, and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1:** Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Big XII, BIG Responsibilities Act of 2020.”
- Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to establish the Vice Chair of Undergraduate Student Congress as the head of the OU delegation at Big XII SGA conferences.
- Section 3:** The Vice Chair of Undergraduate Student Congress shall be the point of contact for all Big XII Universities. The Vice Chair of Undergraduate Student Congress will oversee the OU delegation when traveling to other Universities and will take charge in planning the Big XII conferences when hosted by the University of Oklahoma.
- Section 4:** The Vice-Chair shall work in tandem with the Director of the Department of the Exterior in the Executive Branch and the Chairs of the External Affairs Committees in the Legislative Branch to prepare for the two conferences.
- Section 5:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution, and be nullified one (1) year after passage.

AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2020-2021 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Auxiliary Allocation 8 Act of 2020-2021”

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.

Section 3: APPROPRIATION. The following amounts are hereby allocated to

Section 4: All guidelines and provisions in Title 10 of the Code Annotated shall apply to all funds appropriated in this act.

Section 5: This fiscal year for the account listed in these sections shall end May 7, 2021

Section 6: All unspent money remaining in the accounts listed in Section 3 shall revert to the SGA General Account after May 7, 2021, and the remaining appropriations shall be canceled.

Section 7: This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.
