CONGRESSIONAL BILL AB-108-04 SENATE BILL NO. GF22-XX

AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2022-2023 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Auxiliary Allocation 4 Act of 2022-2023"

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-108-14

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act of Procedure Expelling Representatives from the body; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

- Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Expulsion Bill No.2."
- **Section 2**: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to expel members for excessive unexcused absences. Because Hadi Fawad has accrued excessive unexcused absences, the membership of the aforementioned is pending expulsion.
- **Section 3**: In accordance with the Section 3.4, subsection 2, subsection e of the SGA Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws, "Upon accruing a fourth absence, the Student Congress Secretary shall prepare an act of procedure to expel any member or committee officer who has accrued excessive unexcused absences."

AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Legislation amending the Code Annotated to reflect the necessary and essential changes to nonallowable items; providing for short title, providing for codification, and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Confetti Makes Me Upsetti Bill."
- **Section 2**: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to amend the Student Government Association's Code Annotated to add confetti to the list of non-allowable items.
- **Section 3**: AMENDATORY: The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association's Code Annotated Title X Chapter 2 is amended as follows. For the purposes of this bill, all items added shall be denoted with an <u>underline</u>.

CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION CR-108-16 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. GFXX-XX/GSXX-XX

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution recommending that the Bedlam rivalry between the University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University continue; and providing for distribution.

- Whereas: Bedlam has been an important statewide tradition; and
- Whereas: Fans, athletes, and coaches have enjoyed the experiences and memories of this rivalry; and
- Whereas: Bedlam is one of the longest continuously played rivalry among Football Bowl Subdivision teams; and
- Whereas: The Bedlam rivalry will end after the University of Oklahoma enters the Southeastern Conference; and
- Whereas: There are notable rivalry games played annually between teams of different conferences such as Battle of the Iron Skillet between TCU and SMU, Sunshine Showdown between Florida and Florida State, and Governor's Cup between Kentucky and Louisville; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS AND THE GRADUATE STUDENT SENATE, CONCURRING THEREIN THAT:

- Section 1: Title: This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the "Save Bedlam Act."
- **Section 2:** The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association recommends that athletic departments and university officials the University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University work to maintain the Bedlam rivalry in the following ways:

- 1. Schedule an annual nonconference match between the University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University for sports outside of football.
 - a. An annual nonconference match can be scheduled for men's basketball, women's basketball, baseball, softball, men's golf, women's golf, men's tennis, women's tennis, men's cross country, women's cross country, men's track and field, and women's track and field.
- 2. Coordinate a home-and-home series for football no later than the 2038-39 football season.
- 3. Encourage RSOs from both schools to collaborate and host events together to maintain the Bedlam spirit.

CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION CR-108-17 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. GFXX-XX

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution to discourage the use of straight ticket voting in the State of Oklahoma and encouraging abolition of the practice; and providing for distribution.

- Whereas: Straight ticket voting was used in more than 710,200 instances in the 2020 election in Oklahoma; and
- Whereas: Straight ticket voting discourages voters from researching candidate stances prior to voting; and
- Whereas: Straight ticket voting promotes partisanship, rather than informed voting; and
- Whereas: Voters have access to sites such as okvoterportal.okelections.us to retrieve sample ballots to prepare research before the election; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS AND THE GRADUATE STUDENT SENATE, CONCURRING THEREIN THAT:

- **Section 1:** Title: This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the "Informed Voter Act of 2022."
- **Section 2:** The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association discourages the use of straight ticket voting in the November 2022 General Election and promotes the use of well-informed voting practices in all future elections such as:
 - 1. Reviewing sample ballots as shown on okvoterportal.okelections.us.
 - 2. Attending "town hall" discussions with candidates when plausible.
 - 3. Researching candidate websites, social media pages, and interview transcripts.
 - 4. Voting not based on party, but on beliefs shared between voters and candidates.

- **Section 3:** The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association urges the Oklahoma State Legislature to end the practice of straight ticket voting in the State of Oklahoma.
- **Section 4:** The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association commits to providing students with the proper resources to aid them in making well-informed voting decisions. The Student Government Association may do this in many ways, including publishing candidate infographics, providing links to sample ballots, holding candidate forums, and spreading election day information.
