#### CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION CR-111-04

#### AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Resolution Recognizing the month of February as Black History Month; and providing for distribution.

Whereas:	Black History Month is celebrated in the month of February; and
Whereas:	Black History Month was federally established through Congress in 1986 in Public Law <sup>1</sup> ; and
Whereas:	The month of February was chosen to honor the birthdays of Frederick Douglas and Abraham Lincoln; and
Whereas:	Black History Month is used to promote the identity, culture, and the contributions of Black or African American people throughout the United States; and
Whereas:	Black History Month is also used to educate the American public on the challenges Black and African American people have faced throughout history and today; and
Whereas:	In Fall 2023, 1516 students or 5.3% of the University of Oklahoma's Student Body who was enrolled identified as Black and African American students <sup>2</sup> ; and
Whereas:	Black students are often underrepresented in higher education; and
Whereas:	Educational institutions have historically been biased or inaccurate on the retelling of American Black History due to systematic discriminatory structures and beliefs; and
Whereas:	The University of Oklahoma promotes Diversity on its campus, meaning that "all individuals and viewpoints are represented and included"; and
Whereas:	The University of Oklahoma also promotes Inclusion, meaning that, "all have a sense of belonging in our environment of cultivated respect and care" <sup>3</sup> ; and

Whereas:	The recognition of Black History Month brings awareness and discussion on the history of Black Americans, not only at the University of Oklahoma, but also across the nation; and
Whereas:	Accurate stories and discussion of Black history and cultures help to reduce stigma, giving the opportunity for more inclusive environments; and
Whereas:	Recognizing Black History Month also gives way to recognizing the Black faculty and staff that serve as role models for the community at the University of Oklahoma; therefore

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS THAT:

Section 1:	Title: This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the "Black History Month Resolution of 2024."			
Section 2:	The University of Oklahoma Undergraduate Student Congress recognizes the month of February as Black History Month.			
Section 3:	The University of Oklahoma Undergraduate Student Congress recognizes and honors the Black students at The University of Oklahoma in addition to their culture and heritage.			
Section 4:	The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association Undergraduate Student Congress condemns any laws and policies that previously or currently suppress or harm individuals recognized within this resolution.

## CONGRESSIONAL BILL AB-110-03 SENATE BILL NO. GS24-XX

#### AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2023-2024 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Auxiliary Allocation 13 Act of 2023-2024"
- **Section 2:** PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.

## CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-111-10

## AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act of Procedure expelling a representative from the Congressional Body; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

- Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Expulsion Bill No. 1."
- **Section 2**: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to expel members for excessive unexcused absences. Loni'e Austin has accrued excessive unexcused absences, the membership of the aforementioned is pending expulsion.
- **Section 3**: In accordance with Section 3.4, subsection 2, subsection e of the SGA Undergraduate Student Congress Bylaws, "Upon accruing a forth absence, the Student Congress Secretary shall prepare an act of procedure to expel any member or committee officer who has accrued excessive unexcused absences."
