CONGRESSIONAL BILL AB-107-02 SENATE BILL NO. GF21-XX

AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2021-2022 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Auxiliary Allocation 10 Act of 2021-2022"

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.

CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION CR-107-02 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. GFXX-XX/GSXX-XX

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution which recommends increased education and awareness for the dangers of vaping and nicotine for all students at the University of Oklahoma; and providing for distribution.

- Whereas: A significant number of students have vaped on campus; and
- Whereas: There are serious dangers with nicotine and the chemicals inside each E-Cigarette¹; and
- Whereas: Vaping has been linked to lung health issues including lung cancer²; and
- Whereas: Non-vaping students are still at risk of exposure to secondhand smoke; and
- Whereas: It is the duty of SGA to keep our constituents, the student body safe; and
- Whereas: Students should receive education on the effects and consequences from vaping; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS AND THE GRADUATE STUDENT SENATE, CONCURRING THEREIN THAT:

- Section 1: Title: This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the "Vaping and Nicotine Education Act."
- **Section 2:** The OU Student Government Association recommends that OU Health Promotions educate the Student Body on the dangers of vaping and nicotine in the following ways:
 - 1. Increase content on the dangers of vaping and nicotine in the Alcohol and Other Drugs Training done by OU Health Promotions.
 - a. Consequences for the use of vaping and nicotine products on campus should be addressed.
 - b. The presentation should inform students the dangers vaping poses on their body and bystanders around.
 - c. Information should also consist about the potential spread of diseases like mononucleosis.

	A Congressional Resolution to allow students the ability to

Whereas:	Oklahoma is ranked 47th in the nation for higher education quality; An increase in funds allocated to improving Higher Education could improve Oklahoma's national ranking; and
Whereas:	Higher education is imperative for teacher and nurse retention; Approximately 30,000 educators have left the state of Oklahoma to pursue jobs in neighboring states; and
Whereas:	Research indicates that for every dollar invested by state appropriations, The higher education system creates \$9.40 in terms of economic output; and
Whereas:	Approximately 87% of Oklahoma residents who attend University, and graduate with a bachelor's degree stay in Oklahoma and retain employment in the state at least a year after graduation; and
Whereas:	Higher education allows residents of Oklahoma the ability to contribute to the Oklahoma economy and encourage financial growth which benefits the state of Oklahoma; therefore
