CONGRESSIONAL BILL AB-107-03 SENATE BILL NO. GF20-XX

AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2021-2022 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Auxiliary Allocation 11 Act of 2021-2022"

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-107-03 SENATE BILL GSXX-XX/GFXX-XX

AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Procedure amending Title IX of the Code Annotated, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

- Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "SGA PAE Establishment Act of 2022."
- **Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to establish the SGA Partnership for Athletic Environmentalism (PAE).
- **Section 3:** AMENDATORY: A new chapter shall be added to SGA Code Annotated § Title IX. For the purposes of this bill, all items added shall be denoted with an <u>underline</u>.

1) <u>Name</u>

This board shall be called the "SGA Partnership for Athletic Environmentalism.

2) <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of the Partnership for Athletic Environmentalism is to assist in the communication between OU Athletics, Recycling, Energy and Sustainability Services and the Student Government Association. The Partnership will meet with the intention of expanding recycling facilities at OU Athletic events.

3) <u>Membership</u>

- a) <u>The Chair of the Partnership shall be the Congress Sustainability Committee</u> <u>Chair</u>
- b) <u>Membership for the PAE shall be as follows:</u>
 - The Chair of the Partnership
 - <u>A member of the Congress Sustainability Committee assigned by the Chair</u> of the Partnership
 - The Director of the Interior for the Executive Cabinet
 - <u>The Director of OU's Energy and Sustainability Services or their assigned</u>
 <u>proxy.</u>
 - The Supervisor of Refuse and Recycling or their assigned proxy.
 - <u>The OU Athletics Director of Event Management or their assigned proxy.</u>
