AS INTRODUCED

An Act appointing the Chair of the SGA It's On Us Taskforce; providing for codification; providing for a short title; and providing for an effective date

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- **Section 1:** Title: This act may be known and shall be cited as the "It's On Us Chair Appointment Act of 2020"
- **Section 2:** Purpose: To appoint a Chair to the SGA It's On Us Taskforce.
- **Section 3:** In accordance with Title X, Chapter 7, Section 29 of the SGACA, the following student shall be appointed to serve as Chair of the SGA It's On Us Taskforce:
 - Micayla Valentin Chair of It's On Us Taskforce
- **Section 4:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-103-23

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act of Procedure amending the name of the Parking Appeals Board Act; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

- **Section 1**: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Parking Board Title Clarification Act."
- Section 2: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to amend the University of Oklahoma's Student Government Association's Code Annotated to clarify the title and references of the Parking Appeals Board.
- Section 3: AMENDATORY: Title IV, Chapter 4 and subsequent Sections of the University of Oklahoma's Student Government Association's Code Annotated is amended as follows:
 - 16. Membership. The Student Parking Appeals Court <u>Board</u> shall consist of two (2) teams, each consisting of a chairperson and two (2) judges.
 - 17. Selection. The Judges of the Student Parking Appeals Court <u>Board</u> shall be appointed by the SGA President and approved by both houses of the legislature. Judges shall serve until they resign, cease to be regularly enrolled students at the University of Oklahoma, are impeached and convicted for cause, or are eligible for termination as per guidelines established under Section Seventeen (17) of this Chapter.
 - 18. Rules of Procedure. The SGA Student Parking Appeals Court Board shall establish and publish internal rules and procedures that will be in line with the SGA Constitution, SGA Code Annotated, and University policy, and the University of Oklahoma Transit division's mission

- statement and policies for parking regulations. The SGA Student Parking Appeals Court <u>Board</u> shall ensure that the SGA Student Superior Court has the most up to date version of their rules
- 19. Salary. The Student Parking Appeals Court <u>Board</u> Judges are appointed at the minimum wage but not funded by SGA; the positions are reimbursed through the Parking and Transit Office.
- **Section 4**: AMENDATORY: Title X, Chapter 5, Section 30, Subsection a of the University of Oklahoma's Student Government Association's Code Annotated is amended as follows:
 - a. Traffic Court Justices <u>Student Parking Appeals Board Judges</u>. The Traffic Court Justices <u>Student Parking Appeals Board Judges</u> are appointed at minimum wage, but not funded by SGA; the positions are reimbursed through the Parking and Transit Office.
- **Section 4:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.
- **Section 5:** Upon enactment, copies of this bill should be sent to:
 - Kris Glenn, Director of Parking Administration
 - Chief Justice of the Parking Appeals Board

A Concurrent Resolution for an increase in the higher education budget and an increase in the funding of faculty salaries.

Whereas: The fiscal year 2020 appropriation for higher education by the State of Oklahoma

was \$802,070,058. The fiscal year 2021 total budget need is \$927,070,058 which is a

\$125,000,000 increase in higher education funding.

Whereas: This would be a 15.6% increase in the Higher Education Budget.

Whereas: The most recent national rankings from the Southern Regional Education Board

list Oklahoma as 45th in the average faculty salary and show that average salaries in

Oklahoma's colleges and universities are more than 15% below other states. Additional funding for faculty salary increases is critical to our public institutions' efforts to competitively retain and recruit quality faculty in nursing, business,

education, sciences, engineering and other high-demand programs that are essential

to meet Oklahoma's workforce needs.

Whereas: Additional funding for faculty salary increases is critical to our public institutions'
