Schneider: Wish I was here in person. I've been in Congress since freshman year. Every Tuesday I've made sure y'all listened to my opinion. ConAd or die. No other committees. You won't regret trying something you're interested in. Even if it doesn't work out, you won't wonder what if. Don't be scared. This year, when we made Fox News, it was scary. We might think what will alums think, but that's not our responsibility. Don't be scared. Remember if you're trying to do something for someone on campus, someone in your district feels the same way. Shoutout everyone in ConAd. Love you Lauren Patton. This is sad.

DeAngeli: Over the past four years, I've served on Green Week, SEC, others, and Congress. I'm going to highlight the skill I think is most important: empathy. We need it to solve student issues. If we don't talk to them or do our research, we may risk completing the project too soon. This is why you don't see legislation from some committees, who have already helped students find resources or administrators. You all did this necessary work, thank you for that. You don't have to take into consideration what off campus people think, but staff and administration should be treated with empathy. Staff member working to do a good job for their university. If you hear that Congress wants to hear something, you might see something that blames you or is incorrect, but you think they might not be keen to listen. Scenario two, one day you get a resolution you were expecting. A student already contacted you. You discussed ways you can help students more. Student explained why this appealed to students. They sent you a thank you note afterwards. You tell other staff how awesome it was to work with Congress and they should do that too. Maybe not the exact way staff will respond, but you're more likely to get info you need if you approach staff with empathy. They genuinely listen to what you have to say if you approach them with compassion. We have some people in Congress who did debate in high school. But we need to clarify the meaning of debate in Congress. Advocate for conversations instead of asserting opinions. Then we get something that reflects multiple mindsets. This way we truly

represent all students. You all are so capable of effecting change on campus. You're smart and talented and you can do it. Congress is super cool and it gives you opportunities. Overall, without all of you, I'd have been nothing. When I was running for chair, I ran on helping everybody. I wanted to distribute it to the rest of you, because you guys are so much more capable than just me. I sincerely want to thank every one of you for your contributions. I had a blast and was so honored to have held this position. I'm proud to have known and served you and wish you luck on your endeavors.

Chism: I'm Hennessey Chism, and I was the International Studies representative. Congress was a core part of my college experience. When I came in it was much different. There were more cliques, and we used to not even vote on bills but yell consent. I was budget chair then. It was only two years ago. It's given me so much in the last four years, skills, friends, headaches. I want to say: listen to George. Some of you don't know him, but he's the advisor. George has been here much longer than we've been here. He knows everything about SGA. Ask his opinion on everything. A lot of times, we have great ideas and we push it through committee and goes to the body and George hasn't seen it. Talk to him. He's also such a good friend and I'll miss him. Next, hard thing for Congress to hear, but Congress is far from where it should be. Fighting over things that don't really matter. How a resolution looks, or a source, but it doesn't matter. Students don't know the difference. Instead of reading agenda, we have debate. There's cliques and gossiping. This isn't everyone or all the time, but we could be so much better. Don't write about how professors need to change when you haven't spoken to them. Lastly, find out who you are outside of OU, between Lindsey and Boyd. You're not a Congress representative out there. You're just you. Who are you? What do you like and do in your spare time? You don't plan things when you're not in college. Take internships, study abroad. If you don't know who you are outside this university. Find out who you want to be without using titles and things you're involved in as part of your identity. Old Business

Motion to reconsider AB-103-10 and AB-103-09 jointly Representative Buxton seconded by Representative Lange

Patton: Hi guys. Welcome back. To explain, there was a miscommunication and an issue that George, Melissa, and I discussed and all played a role in. I left under the impression I was supposed to disregard the GSS grants. We never had an in person conversation to clarify. Thank you Hennessey for catching it. We should have caught it at some point. This isn't something I did because I forgot something. The cheat sheet sent out says the amounts we decreased, and I wanted to show you we didn't decrease groups with good fiscal. We decreased the increases they got. We had to decrease a lot of groups. For good fiscal groups, it's still more than they got last year. If they did get decreases, they had medium or poor fiscal. Last round we weren't pinching pennies, if they had iffy fiscal we were generous. We decided this time to give those organizations decreases.

Bouch: Can you go through the cuts to the increases you had to make?

Patton: Go through each one or general process?

Bouch: Each organization you cut.

Patton: We cut the largest organizations that we gave significant increases. Black Student Association and International Advisory Committee were cut, but they still received increases from last year. IAC got more than last year, BSA kept the same because of large increases in prior years. HASA and American Indian Student Association, we wanted to build a new tier of cultural societies that serve a large group, but were cut, but they still received an increase.

Hillis: Question on increases. Is the increase based off their budget or more than what their budget asked for? Did you overfund?

Patton: We fully fund about 5% of organizations. Some organizations ask for more money than they know they're going to get. Good to see an overview of everything they want to do. Increases based upon us knowing we know their budget allows for that and for bigger events.

Bouch: FA to change the bill we're reconsidering to the new one sent out via email?

Patton: Yes for both.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL **CB-104-04** SENATE BILL GFXX-XX

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act of Legislation updating language in the SGA Code Annotated; providing short title; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

- **Section 1**: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Crimson Leadership Association Name Change Act"
- **Section 2**: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to eliminate all mentions of the mentions of the organization named "Sooner Freshman Council" and replace it with "Crimson Leadership Association"
- Section 3: AMENDATORY: All instances of the name "Sooner Freshman Council" shall be eliminated from the SGA Code Annotated and replaced with "Crimson Leadership Association" in accordance with CB-103-09 and GF19-28.
- **Section 4:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. CB-104-02

AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Procedure appointing committee officers for Sessions 104 and 105; providing short title; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

Section 1: This Act shall be known and may be cited as "An Act of Procedure Appointing the Committee Chairs for Sessions 104 and 105."
