## **Officer Reports:**

- **Chair's Report:** Hi Everyone! The general application will close on September 3 at 6:00 p.m. We are looking for a Representative to serve as liaison to the Faculty Senate. Moving on to COVID-19 policy, the University has shifted its message from encouraging masks to expecting masks. The University is now requiring masking in classes who have students test positive for COVID-19. The administration cannot implement stricter COVID-19 policy because it is limited by state law and executive order. In the coming weeks, we will be recommending our COVID-19 policy suggestions to the administration.
- Vice Chair's Report: Hello Everyone! Welcome back and I hope you had a great first week of school. I'm looking forward to seeing all of you more and getting some great projects done this semester! I have quite a few things planned for this month. I've mostly been working on our new associate program, the SGA service project, and planning orientation. I will have more details on those items for all of you once we appoint our new members so that they are informed. I will begin coming to committee meetings this weekend and I'm excited to see all your faces and see what each committee has planned! My office hours are on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday for the semester, I will send them in the GroupMe now that I have them finalized. I would love for you all to come visit and as always please don't hesitate to reach out if you need anything at all!
- Secretary's Report: Hi Everyone! I hope everyone had a great first week of classes. I am super excited to see everyone in person and for this upcoming semester and year. I am currently in the process of updating a few items related to the secretary position on Engage and the SGA Website. I feel transparency is extremely important in the secretary role, so I am working on making

information related to Congress more accessible to all member of SGA. I will be sending an update via email to all members of Congress about the new Congressional Involvement Program. Since we had our first general body meeting on August 31<sup>st</sup>, we will start the program for the month of September. We talked about the plan for Campus Outreach, Safety, and Concerns this year, such as light walks and new project ideas.
- Congressional Administration: Hi Everyone! My name is Foster Hillis (he/him), and I am the chairman of Congressional Administration Committee. I wanted to update you all on some numbers from the general application. Currently, we have 181 applications from 121 unique submission. The general application will close at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 3. Municode is officially live. We are putting a pause on any Acts of Procedure and Acts of Legislation while we continue to develop Municode.
- **External Affairs:** Hi all! My name is Jayke Flaggert (he/him), and I am the chair of the External Affairs Committee. Recently, the Norman City Council passed a resolution encouraging residents and community members to wear masks. The resolution did pass by a vote of 6-2. We will be having a mayor forum with Norman Mayor Breea Clark. It was originally scheduled for October 1, but there is a scheduling conflict. Now, the forum will be after the OU-Texas game.
- **Human Diversity:** Hi Everybody! My name is Caitlyn Harman (she/her), and I am the chair of the Human Diversity Committee. We plan to continue the newsletter. We hope to make sure food signage is available at campus dining for students. Right now, the Goddard Health Services does not provide free COVID-19 testing. # CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-106-08 SENATE BILL GSXX-XX/GFXX-XX

#### AS INTRODUCED

An Act submitting the Fall 2021 Unscheduled Holiday; providing for short title, providing for legislative intent, and providing for an effective date.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1:	Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Red River Holiday Act of 2021."		
Section 2:	Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to officially submit an unscheduled holiday to the University President for approval pursuant to Section 5.15 of the Regents policy manual.		
Section 3:	The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association officially submits Friday, October 8 <sup>th</sup> as the Fall 2021 Student Holiday.		
Section 4:	This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.
