- o External Affairs: Hello Everyone! It's great to see all the new faces here today, I really look forward to getting to know all of the new members during orientation. For those of you who don't know me yet, my name is Weslie Griffin, I'm a Junior, Aviation Major and I'm the External Affairs Committee Chair. A little about EA, our committee deals with all issues concerning external organizations, specifically with local, state, tribal and federal governments. We met officially this week and saw CR-108-14: the "National Voter Registration Day 2022 Resolution," which we gave a rec of do pass. You'll hear more about it tonight when the body sees it, but voter registration day is next Tuesday, and it's gonna be a bunch of fun. EA is going to be tabling with OK Votes, and everyone is welcome to join us. Our meeting this week is going to be at 3:15 to accommodate for orientation, but as per usual everyone is invited to join. - O Human Diversity: My name is Carolyn and I am the chair of human diversity. Our committee focuses on diversity related issues and advocating for inclusion and equality. For this semester we want to focus on mental health resources, school supplies drive, HD writing series, and trick or treating on campus with different cultural clubs. For those of you that aren't familiar with us, we ensure that the university is staying environmentally sustainable through policies, projects, and legislation. This includes what the University is funding, gas emissions, food insecurity, and more. On Sunday, we had our first Trash Walk of the year at the Duck Pond to do some post-game day cleanup. We usually have those once a month and it does count as a constituent service point, so all of you are welcome to come to those. After our Trash Walk, we met unofficially and talked about our current projects. We are picking back up our project on specialized recycling through TerraCycle in the dorms and are planning to meet with Housing and Food by the end of the month. We are also revisiting reusable to-go containers in the dining halls, which is something that was set back by COVID. On Sunday, we have an ambassador from a sustainable water bottle company called Gen Z Water coming to our meeting.
- University Policy: Hey guys, my name is Annie Mullins! I am a Junior Pre Law-Political Science major, minoring in Criminal Investigation. If you don't know what UPOL is, we deal with policies regarding the university. We ensure that policies implemented by the University are helpful to the entire OU Community, whether it be indirect or direct. We also ensure that policy is equitable and necessary in its inception. UPOL met officially this week! We had a higher attendance then last week, which makes me very happy. We saw CR-108-13 "Honoring the 2022 OU Women's Gymnastics Team Resolution." CONGRESSIONAL BILL AB-108-02 SENATE BILL NO. GF22-XX

AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2022-2023 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Auxiliary Allocation 2 Act of 2022-2023"

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.

AS INTRODUCED

CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION CR-108-14

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Resolution recognizing September 20th, 2022, as National Voter Registration Day; and providing for distribution.

Whereas: September 20th, 2022, has been designated as National Voter Registration Day by

nationalvoterregistrationday.org; and

Whereas: The University of Oklahoma prides itself on civic engagement, with voting being one

of the most basic and important civic duties; and

Whereas: The 2020 election cycle showed a significant increase of voter turnout and

registration from college students, with 66% of eligible college students voting in the

2020 election; and

Whereas: Despite seeing an 14.3% increase from previous years, The University of Oklahoma

showed a lower voting rate than the national average, with 63.5% of our eligible

students voting; and

Whereas: The University of Oklahoma surpassed the national average in voter registration,

with 81.5% if our eligible voters registered to vote; and

Whereas: Trends show that voter turnout and voter registration decrease during mid-term

election years, such as 2022; and

Whereas: The 2022 election cycle holds many important elections, including a gubernatorial

election and two Senate elections in Oklahoma, as well as Congressional elections

nation-wide: and

Whereas: This year provides the unique opportunity for the minimization of voter loss in 2022,

due to the high registration and voter turnout in 2020.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS AND THE GRADUATE STUDENT SENATE, CONCURRING THEREIN THAT:

Section 1: Title: This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the "National Voter

Registration Day 2022 Act".

Section 2: The Student Government Association recognizes September 20, 2022, as National Voter Registration Day Section 3: The Student Government Association strives to increase the civic engagement of students on campus and will partner with Registered Student Organizations to help increase voter registration throughout the year. Section 4: The External Affairs committee will specifically partner with Oklahoma Votes on National Voter Registration Day to help increase voter registration on campus.
