CONGRESSIONAL BILL CB-109-01

AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act of Procedure Appointing Associates for the 109th Congressional Session; providing for short title, providing for codification, and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CONGRESS:

- **Section 1:** Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Re-Appointment Act of 2023."
- **Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to appoint the following Associates and Representatives to the One Hundred and Ninth (109th) Congressional Session.
- **Section 3:** The following SGA Members shall be appointed to Representative Seats in accordance with the SGA Constitution:

Michael Stoyak- International Studies District Ashlyn Coxson- University College District Caleb Robinson- University College District

Section 4: The following SGA Members shall be appointed to Associateships in accordance with the SGA Constitution:

Aiden Dodd Audrey Dao Olivia Payson

Section 5: This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

CONGRESSIONAL BILL AB-109-01 SENATE BILL NO. GF22-XX

AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to appropriations; providing for short title; stating purpose; appropriating Auxiliary Funding for the 2022-2023 process; stating appropriation guidelines; establishing expiration deadline; directing transfer of unused funds by deadline; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Auxiliary Allocation 7 Act of 2022-2023"

Section 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the funds of the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association to the organizations mentioned within.
