

STUDENT CONDUCT PROCESS

Quick Reference

- Incident Report is received (from faculty, community member, university police).
- Hearing officer determines if incident falls with conduct jurisdiction.
- If so, charges are filed, and student is provided notice that the Student Conduct process has been initiated.
- Charged student has five (5) business days from receiving the notice to schedule their mandatory meeting with the Office of Student Conduct.
 - Failure to respond may result in the student's case being heard by default.
- The charged student will have the opportunity to respond to allegations and provide information relevant to the investigation.
- The Conduct Officer will review all information during the mandatory meeting and determine whether the student's behavior constitutes a violation of the [Student Rights and Responsibilities Code](#).
 - If a violation is supported, sanctions will be imposed in accordance with Section VII of the *Code*.
 - If a student disagrees that a violation of the *Code* exists, the student may request a hearing in writing within two (2) days of the mandatory meeting.
