



Mandatory Educational Session Overview

As mandated by the University of Oklahoma and Fraternity and Sorority Programs and Services, **all new members** of Greek organizations must attend three educational sessions over the following topics: 1) Hazing Education and Reporting Resources, 2) Greek Alcohol and Other Drugs Training (AOD), and the 3) Consent Conversation 2.0 (CC).

It is the responsibility of the chapter to ensure new members attend their required trainings. Chapters should contact their council advisor for an updated attendance record of new members.

FSPS facilitates these sessions each semester to provide all students an opportunity to attend. Review the below structure to see when each council's membership attends training.

Please note that students only need to do these sessions once. For example, if a student participates in IFC Formal Recruitment and later joins MGC, they will only need to attend the Consent Conversation 2.0, as they would have already been trained on AOD and Hazing.

**For Panhellenic COB additions – if a student participates in Panhellenic Recruitment until Preference Round, they will receive the AOD and Hazing Education and Resource Reporting trainings. If a student joins later through COB, they won't need to complete those two trainings again. However, if the student withdrew from Formal Recruitment before Preference Round or did not participate in Formal Recruitment at all, they would need to make up all trainings during the FSPS Make-Up Educational Sessions (FSPS hosts 5 per semester).*
