



Material Management Uses AiM Efficiencies



In September, Material Management started using AiM's reorder generator to automatically create purchase orders for inventory items. To use the reorder generator, inventory items require a minimum/maximum quantity, reorder level/quantity, and a vendor catalogue part profile. This catalogue contains all pricing information from the major vendors used for the inventory items, such as Home Depot Pro, Fastenal or Waxie. A vendor preference is established to signal to AiM where to purchase each part from.

Every 7 days, Material Management team members use the 'Generate Inventory Reorder Procedure' to create the purchase orders needed to replenish inventory. AiM looks at the current inventory quantities and automatically adds line items with the established reorder quantity for inventory items under minimum. Material Management team members can edit quantities or pricing if necessary and then submit for approval.

The reorder generator eliminates the need for Material Management team members to identify the correct vendor to purchase from, calculate the quantities needed, add line items to a purchase order, and research every price from the vendor. Additionally, following this process, Material Management is able to receive and disburse inventory items directly to the bins when product arrives. This step eliminates the need for external inventory adjustments to be created for each purchase order line item which allows the stock items to be added to the shelf immediately.

"Following the inventory reorder generator process has eliminated significant room for user errors while cutting the time in half that it takes to complete inventory replenishment purchase orders and eliminated dozens of weekly transactions created to add product received into inventory. The efficiencies created by this new process has afforded us more time to focus on the inventory expansion project which, in turn, will benefit greatly by the changes implemented."

Tree Planting



The Department of Facilities Management invited all on campus to participate in a service-learning event in which we discussed demonstrated process transplanting a tree from Jacobson Hall to the south side of Felgar Street on our main campus. This initiative was part of our commitment to preserving greenery on campus. The Shumard Oak tree at Jacobson Hall needed to be moved due to Jacobson Hall being renovated and expanded. This event was a hands-on opportunity to learn about tree care, environmental stewardship, and the significance of maintaining greenery on campus.

Homecoming Recap





Thanksgiving Football Recap





2023 Performance Reviews

There are exciting changes coming with annual performance reviews! First, the university is transitioning from the current paper process to Cornerstone - an online performance management system. Within Cornerstone, team members now can establish and work towards goals applicable to their position and department. This month supervisors have been assigning front-line team members with at least three department-wide goals for 2023, and if applicable, any additional established goals within the Cornerstone website. Beginning Jan 2 - Jan 31, team members will then be tasked with logging into Cornerstone (using their OU 4x4 and password) to begin their self-review. This will allow team members an opportunity to provide feedback on how they believe their 2023 performance was. Once completed, Supervisors will then complete the performance review capturing their team members' contributions and performance for the 2023 year.
