The Medical Humanities Scholars Program (for Incoming High School Seniors) and The Medical Humanities Minor (for OU Undergraduates).

If you are interested in the art and science of medicine, you are invited to apply to an exciting interdisciplinary program administered through the OU Honors College and the OU College of Medicine. You can obtain both your bachelor of arts and doctor of medicine degrees in the Medical Humanities Scholars Program through a course of study designed to meet the growing need to produce well-rounded physicians who possess the analytical skills of the liberal arts.

As a Medical Humanities Scholar, you will have undergraduate opportunities to study overseas at more than 170 universities that participate in the University of Oklahoma's Education Abroad Program. You also may wish to contribute to Blood and Thunder: Musings on the Art of Medicine, OU's medical student-produced journal, which has become internationally renowned for its artistic and literary contributions.

## THE MEDICAL HUMANITIES SCHOLARS PROGRAM

- As a Medical Humanities Scholar, you may major in the humanities | social sciences | and/or sciences.
- You also will design your own minor in the medical humanities, focusing on the subjects you find most stimulating, which could include: bioethics | the history of medicine | literature and medicine | music and medicine | spirituality and medicine | and cross-cultural dimensions of health and disease.
- Regardless of your major, you will complete the standard pre-medical curriculum.
- You will complete mini-internships with local physicians and with non-physician healthcare providers.

Medical Humanities Scholars receive provisional acceptance at the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine upon acceptance into the program.
